Greetings to the Church at Elloree,

In the past few months, we have discussed "Spiritual Gifts" and what it means to be a Disciple. I believe that Paul gave us a great definition of what Disciples are called to do in the book of Philippians (2:12), as he said "...continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling...". We know that we cannot "work **for**" salvation because "it is the gift of God, not of works", however, as believers (already saved) we have a responsibility to "work out our salvation" throughout our life and that process is called "Discipleship" (sanctification). It means you are to become like Christ and to become a "Minister" for Christ, fulfilling the purpose for which you were created.
