Darrel L. Anderson tells the story of: A mother, wishing to encourage her young son's progress at the piano, bought tickets to a Paderewski performance. When the night arrived, they found their seats near the front of the concert hall and eyed the majestic Steinway waiting on the stage. While the mother was talking with a friend, the little boy slipped away unnoticed. When eight o'clock arrived, the house lights dimmed, the audience quieted and only then did they notice the little boy sitting at the piano innocently picking out "Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star." His mother gasped, but before she could react, the master pianist appeared on the stage and quickly moved to the keyboard. He whispered to the boy, "Don't quit – keep playing." Then leaning over, Paderewski reached down with his left hand and began filling in a bass part. Soon his right arm reached around the other side, encircling the child, to add a running obbligato. Together, the old master and the young novice held the crowd mesmerized.

The story was a beautiful reminder to me of how Jesus uses the feeble but sincere attempts of "growing" believers to be a part of His Kingdom's work here on earth. He has plans for each of us in this (His) Church. I think of the many times He has come and wrapped His loving arms around me as He whispered in my ear, "Don't quit, keep playing".
